Total of \$5000

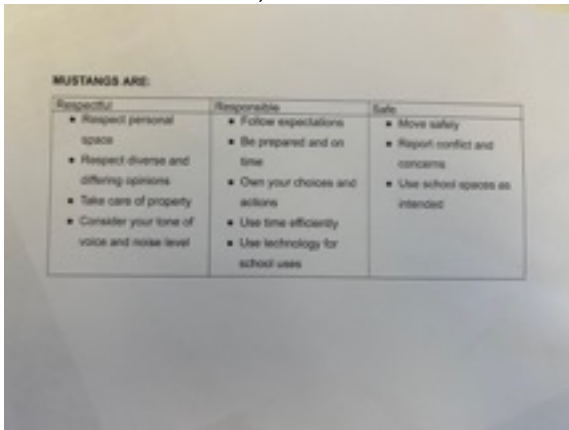
